

Albert Almont

New York

- 1907 Almont & Dumont play at the Orpheum in Brooklyn (news article).
- 1914 Al Almont & Ms. Dumont play at the Orpheum. Al played the septiphone, with six bells and lights inside each that lit when played. They were an instrument duet (news article).
- 1940s Tommy Dorsey used an Almont mouthpiece and made his trombone section use them (from former member who didn't like them)
- 1945 Albert Almont, 74, musician and manufacturer of the Almont mouthpiece for trumpet and trombone, died May 3rd in New York. He had the act "Almont & Dumont" and retired from the stage in 1930 (*The Billboard*).
- 1946 Almont mouthpieces wanted by Fred Dittman, 302 Koons Ave, Buffalo NY (*International Musician*, April).
- 1956 Almont mouthpieces for sale by Fred Dittman, 53 Geo. Urban Blvd, Cheektowaga, NY (*International Musician*, July).
