- 1855 Gerhard Charles Aschbach is born on January 15 in Allentown to German immigrant parents (*MTR*, 1913).
- 1876 Music store is founded at #810 Hamilton St., Allentown.
- 1877 Moved to the basement of the Second National Bank at #532 Hamilton St. (directory).
- 1888 Moved across the street to the Osmun & School building at #533 (dir).
- 188? Ad from #533 location says they sold "brass band instruments made by the best manufacturers in Europe."
- Purchased property at #539 Hamilton and opened their new four-story store on October 15th (MTR, 1913; photo 1).
- 1905 Gerhard's two sons Gerhard, Jr. & Adolph are also working at the store.
- 1906 The store is remodeled with bay windows on the front and a 100', 3-story addition on the rear extends it to Court St (*Music Trade Review*).
- 1913 Adolph dies in June & Gerhard, Sr. dies on August 15th (*MTR*).
- 1914 Gerhard, Jr. is the manager following the deaths of both his father and brother in 1913. #539 Hamilton.
- 1929 Gerhard retires and the business closes (MTR).
- 1933 Gerhard, Jr. dies.
