- 1921 First wife Sarah (b.1862) dies in February (death cert).
- 1922 George marries Alice.
- 1930 George Bailey, music store owner, home #63 Hilltop Ave (census).
- 1935 Now living at #115 Concord Ave., Cranston, RI (the business possibly closed in the Depression and he moved to Cranston after 1930).
- 1940 Now at #19 Moses Brown St., Providence, no occupation (census).
- 1942 George dies in Providence on April 10.

A "New American" model cornet has been found with his name. This appears to be a stencil made by B&F of Austria, as their mark is on the middle valve. These date to the early 1900s.
