1832 Christman wins an award for a keyed bugle.

1835 Wins silver medal for trumpets & post horns.

1837 May 3<sup>rd</sup> still at #398 Pearl St (dir).

1837-54 Now at #404 Pearl St (dir).

1845 Listed as importer of musical instruments (dir).

1846 Enters Keyed Bugle in NY exhibition (*NLI*).

Patent #6968 for WWI key layout. Charles G. Christman, musical instruments, #404 Pearl St (dir).

1854 Still at #404 Pearl St (dir).

1855 Now at #391 Pearl St. (dir).

1858 Christman now gone from NYC directory.

1884 Charles dies on October 29th, age 85, Brooklyn.
