

Ernst Ferdinand Glier

Cochecton, NY

- 1827 born in Markneukirchen, Germany (census)
- 1856 Glier family emigrates to US; father Christ. Friedr. Glier is a piano maker (immigration)
- 1860 Ernst Glier buys property in Cochecton area (deed)
- 1864 not listed in the NY State Business Directory
- c.1865 the cornet pictured here is the only one known to exist and is part of the National Music Museum collection; they say that Ernst learned brass making from his father Christian Ferdinand Glier; it uses Allen valves
- 1866 Ernst sells the property purchased in 1860 (deed)
- 1867 listed in the NYS Business Directory as a brass musical instrument manufacturer in Cochecton, NY
- 1870 Glier dies on February 7th at age 43; he is buried with his parents in a Cochecton cemetery; his father is listed in the census as no occupation and living with son Moritz, a farmer in Cochecton
- 1880 Ferdinand Glier, music instruments (census)

Christian Friedrich Glier (1797-1880), born in Germany, emigrated to US in 1856, died in Cochecton, NY; in US goes by Ferdinand

Ernst Ferdinand Glier (1827-1870), same as father; sometimes listed as Ernest Glier

Moritz Glier (1837-1914), probably a brother to Ernst; emigrated in 1856; never listed as a brass maker; sometimes listed as Morris
