

Halary

Paris, France

- 1804 Business established by Jean Hilaire Aste (1775-1840), who used the name Halary-Aste; rue de Malte 12.
- 1815 Making keyed bugles for a Russian duke.
- 1817 Now at rue Mazarine 37.
- 1825 Retired and succeeded by Jean Louis Antoine (1788-1861), who used the name Antoine Halary or Halari.
- 1849 Now at rue Mazarine 33.
- 1856 Now at rue Poitevins 6.
- 1857 Starts using name A. Halary & fils and advertised a branch in London.
- 1859 Licensed to build Sax model brass instruments.
- 1861 Succeeded by son Jules.
- 1863 Building new "Cornet – Solo."
- 1872 Workforce of 35 included ten children.
- 1873 Sold to Coste & Cie, Sudre proprietor [many instruments (bottom right & below) are marked Halari – Sudre and probably date to after 1873].
