## **Paris**

There seem to be at least three companies using this name.

- 1. Lefevre & Cie as marked in this cornopean (photo 1)
- 2. Francois Lafevre marked "\* / Lefevre / A Paris / \* / Brevete / FL / 148 Rue du Theatre" (photos 2&3 have serial numbers in the 4000 range)
- This shop was established in 1812 by Francois Lafevre who dealt mainly in woodwinds and sold the business in 1855. These brass instruments are from a later time and probably stencils by another French maker.
- **3. Henri Lefevre:** these can be marked "Henri Lefevre / Grinnell Bros / Detroit USA / Sole Agents" (photo 4) or just "Henri Lefevre" (photos 5 & 6 & below); they are likely Austrian imports made by B&F and given a French name to sound like better quality (Horn-u-copia.net & auction photos)
