
Forrest J. Nicola

- 1890 Forrest Joy Nicola is born in Des Moines, Iowa on November 19th (WWII draft).
- 1915 Band instructor at the State Univ. of S. Dakota, Vermillion.
- 1920 Forrest Nicola, music, #1239 Clark St., Chicago (census).
- 1923 Forrest Nicola, floor room, Marshall Field & Co., Chicago, h. #4353 N. Troy (directory).
- 1930 Forrest J. Nicola, orchestra musician, #2343 Irving Park Blvd, Chicago (census).
- 19?? Forrest starts making his own trumpet mouthpieces.
- 1940 Granted patent #2,223,668 for foot-operated metronome.

Mouthpieces at right are trumpet & tenor trombone.










#228 S. Wabash from 1950 Sanborn map.
