

# Charles L. Randall

## New York City

- 1908 Charles L. Randall (1879-?) is playing trombone with the Innes Band (news article).
- 1913 Randall records with Conway's Band on Victor as a trombone soloist.
- 1915 Charles L. Randall, musician, #501 W. 171<sup>st</sup> St., New York (directory).
- 1918 Randall, Broadway theatre musician, #62 E. 87<sup>th</sup> St. (draft).
- 1924 Patent #1,489,629 is granted to George K. Cheney (1871-1937) with half assigned to Charles Randall for a collapsible trombone mute. The patent was filed in 1922. Cheney was working for Victor Records until 1925.
- 1936 Randall publishes "Arban's Method for Trombone" with Simone Mantia.
