1840s Roehn trains with G. A. Besson in Paris.

1849 Roehn is a foreman for Beauboeuf as Roehn & Beauboeuf at rue St Denis 268, cour des Bleus, in Paris.

He receives special mention for a “clarion chromatique” at the Paris Exhibition and is on an industrial listing as a manufacturer of brass instruments.

1853 Roehn establishes his own shop at faubourg, St Martin.

1855 Roehn moves to faubourg St Denis 60.

1857 Roehn moves to faubourg St Martin 78.

1858 Roehn sues Sax over patents.

1860 Now at rue des Vinaigriers 52.

1870 Now at rue du Faubourg, St Denis 131 (below).

1880 Roehn exhibits a slide trombone in Paris.
