

Alfred Squire

Cincinnati, Ohio

- 1829 Alfred Squire is born in Dorset, England in November (census).
- 1844 Hannah Hunt Squire is born in Ohio in December.
- 1861-62 Alfred serves as band leader, Ohio 59th CW unit.
- 1864 Alfred serves as band leader, Ohio 153rd CW unit.
- 1870 First listing in June directory. A. Squire, dealer in music and musical instruments, #177 W. 4th St (directory).
- 1871 Now also a publisher of military band music.
- 1874 Squire moves to #173 Elm St (dir).
- 1875 Son William Horace Squire is born December 5.
- 1876 Music book (top photo) states that he is a dealer in brass & German silver band instruments.
- 1878 Moves to #216 Elm St, importer & manuf. of m.i. (dir).
- 1878-1895 Still at #216 Elm St (dir).
- 1886-1903 Squire's Musical Advertiser (monthly).
- 1890 Alfred dies on May 29th of pneumonia, home at #3104 8th St. in Price Hill (death cert).
- 1890-1894 Widow Hannah runs the music store with her brother Jacob.
- 1895-1902 A. Squire's Music house, J.E. Hunt, proprietor (dir).
- 1896-1902 Music store at #528 Elm St (dir).
- 1898 Hannah Squire dies on April 24. Anna F. Squire is listed at the same home address as a music teacher (daughter?).
- 1902 Jacob E. Hunt (1840-1913) retires from running the music store for 35 years (obituary).
- 1903 J.E. Hunt and Squire's music store are both gone (dir).
- Bb Cornet (2nd & 3rd photos) is a copy of the Courtois Koenig model cornet from about 1870 and probably made by Gatrouit of France (author's photo).

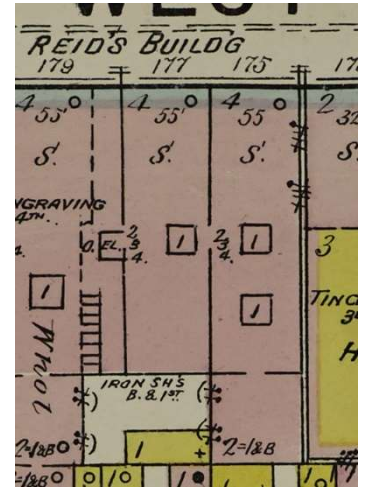
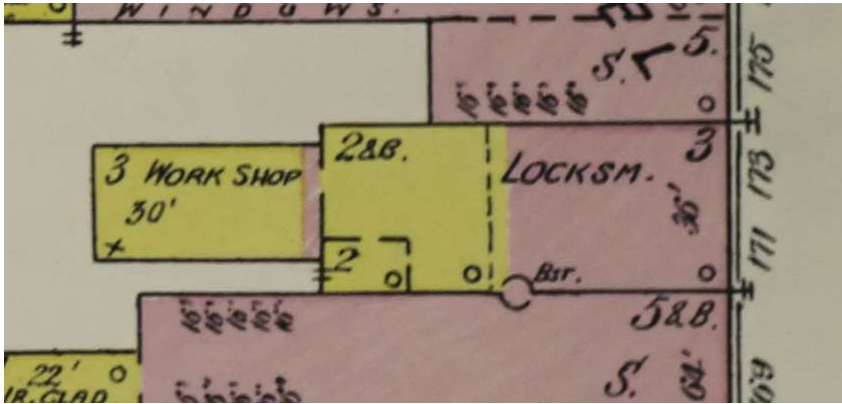

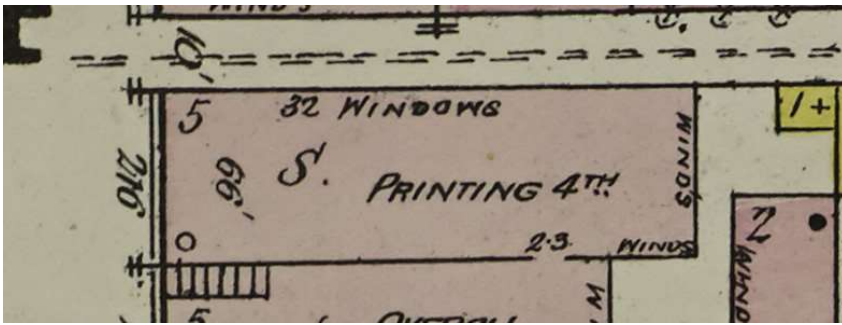
Squire Locations:
