

# Stanley Mouthpieces

**Wm. R. Gratz Import Co. – New York City**

1943 The Stanley and Muck mouthpieces are sold by the William R. Gratz Company in New York (*International Musician*, October).

These do not show up in their ads from 1940 and 1941, so were likely started just after that time. I have not found when they stopped production.

These were likely made just for Gratz and perhaps done by Rudy Muck, since they were dealers for him as well. There are very few surviving examples so may have only been made up to WWII.

Most have the same design shown at right but the one below is quite different; if it's the same maker.
