

Christian Stark & George Kober

- 1856 Christian Stark, mus inst, 67 Chrystie (directory) .
- 1857 Stark & Albrecht, mus inst, #175 Chrystie with John B. Albrecht woodwinds (dir).
- 1858 Christian R. Stark, trumpets, #181 Chrystie. Albrecht just has a home address at #142 Mott so possibly retired (dir).
- 1859-65 Chr. R. Stark, mus inst, #181 Chrystie (dir).
- 1866 Stark & Kober, importers & wholesale dealers in mus inst, #23 & 25 Dey; Christian G. Stark & George Kober (dir).
- 1867 Fire damages the shop of Gerbeth & Seifert at #181 Chrystie St in Feb. They claim to be successors to C. R. Stark (news item).
- 1867-68 Christian G. Stark, mus inst, #10 Maiden Lane; George Kober, mus inst, #23 Dey (dir).
- 1869 C. G. Stark, mus inst, #19 Maiden Lane (dir).
- 1869-73 George Kober, mus inst, #25 Murray (dir).
- 1870-71 C. G. Stark, mus inst, #89 Chambers (dir).
- 1872-73 C. G. Stark, clerk (dir).
- 1874-76 George Kober & Sons, mus inst, #25 Murray (Geo. & Geo. W. Kober). C. G. Stark, mus inst, #25 Murray (dir).
- 1876 George Kober & Sons, #25 Murray (George W. Kober, Jacob G. Schiele, & Christian Stark) (dir).
- 1876 Assignment for benefit of creditors filed on Nov. 23rd by Kober, Stark & Co. (G. W. Kober, C. G. Stark & J. G. Schiele) to Edward R. Holsworth. They had liabilities of \$60,000 mostly to German creditors and \$18,000 in assets (news article).
- 1877 George W. Kober & C. R. Stark, mus inst, #25 Murray.
- 1878 Kober, Stark & Co. dissolved, #25 Murray (dir).
- 1880 Census has George Kober (b.1811) as instrument maker, George W. Kober (1847-1925) as music dealer, and C. Stark (b.1838) as instrument maker.
- 1881-82 Stark & Co., importer of musical inst, #25 Murray, C. R. Stark and Geo. W. Kober.
- 1883 Last year for Stark & Co., #25 Murray; Kober gone (dir).
- 1884-92 C. G. Stark, no occ., clerk, or agent; various addresses.
- Brass found are marked Christian R. Stark (Horn-u-copia.net).
