- 1880 Frances Louise Horne born April 19th in Cambridge, Maine to Ira & Ardella (census & Trescott).
- 1890 Louise performs on cornet for the governor in Newport.
- 1892 Louise starts lessons with R. B. Hall of Waterville, ME and practices 3-4 hours a day.
- 1893 Louise is soloist with Hall's Military Band.
- 1896 She studies with Henry C. Brown, Boston.
- 1897 Playing with Fadettes of Boston.
- 1898 Tours with Cecilia Musical Club.
- 1899 Summer soloist at Norumbega Park, Boston.
- 1900 Soloist for US Ladies Military Band, Providence, RI.
- 1901 Soloist for Tuxedo Ladies Band, Chester Park, Cincinnati.
- 1903 Plays at Iroquois Theater in Chicago, just before the fire.
- 1906 Soloist with Reno Mario & her orchestra at Symphony Hall, Boston. Soloist at Rudolph Hotel, Atlantic City.
- 1908 Soloist with Twelve Navaho Girls, Atlantic City Pier, the Navassar Band, and at the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel with Mrs. Paris Chambers.
- 1910 Married Edmund Stilwell of Kansas City and stopped touring.
- 1920 Living in Kansas City, two daughters, no occupation (census).
- 1930 & 1940 same as 1920
- 1956 Louise dies in Kansas City on September 6.
